Position Summary

Under general supervision, this position undertakes the responsibility of preserving the good working condition, functionality, and safety of the facilities, grounds, and equipment of Explorers Academy. This position includes a great variety of maintenance tasks such as repairs, installations, electrical, plumbing, carpentry, painting, landscaping, and custodial duties as assigned. The maintenance technician must be practical minded with an attention to detail and able to perform both skilled and semi-skilled tasks in correcting and preventing damage to buildings, playgrounds, and equipment. This position also requires providing general agency wide support including the ability and willingness to act as needed in fulfilling the mission, vision, and values of Explorers Academy.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Safely perform repairs and preventative maintenance tasks in a commercial/school setting.

SAFETY

Survey buildings, playgrounds, equipment, and mechanical systems ensuring they are in compliance with health and safety standards
Inspect fire, safety, and security systems and schedule repairs when needed
Respond quickly in the event of an emergency, notify appropriate personnel and follow safety protocols

MAINTENANCE

Perform basic maintenance to electrical systems including troubleshooting
Perform basic plumbing maintenance and functionality
Perform basic heating, air conditioning, and ventilation maintenance and functionality
Conduct landscaping maintenance such as mowing, trimming, sprinkler system repairs, and seasonal snow removal
Undertake activities of pest control and insecticide spraying
Repair and maintain flooring, walls, concrete, locks, doors, paint
Conduct and maintain inventories of tools, equipment, and maintenance supplies
Assist in janitorial duties
